## Standing Rules for the 2006 State Conference

1. **Decorum.** Members of the Conference shall be seated before the opening of the session. No one will be seated except by the pages during any part of the program. Doors will be closed during all programs and reports. No electronic communication devices shall be active or used during business session or other events.
2. **Reports.** Chapter Regents and Committee Chairmen are required to prepare two typewritten copies of their reports for the State Conference. One for the Recording secretary and one for the State Regent. Their report shall be read during the session. In the absence of a State Officer or Chair, her report will be filed. In the absence of a Chapter Regent, her report may be read by the Chapter Vice Regent or her alternate.
3. **Program.** Any business unfinished at the time of recess shall be resumed at the next business session. If business scheduled for one session is finished before the time of adjournment, items scheduled for the next session may follow.
4. **Addressing a question.** Only members may address a question. No member shall be allowed to speak more than twice on the same question on the same day nor more than two minutes at a time.
5. **Address the chair.** When addressing the Chair, a Delegate shall give her name and that of her Chapter. Procedure of addressing the Conference: "Madam State Regent and Daughters" or "Madam State Regent, Daughters and Guests". DURING Business sessions, she need only address the chair, "Madam State Regent" (giving name and chapter).
6. **Motions.** Motions shall be presented in writing and signed by the maker and the seconder and sent immediately to the Recording Secretary.
7. **Recommendations.** Recommendations submitted by the State Board of Management or Executive Board may be presented directly to the State Conference.
8. **Authority.** Robert's rules of Order Newly Revised shall be the authority on parliamentary procedure.
